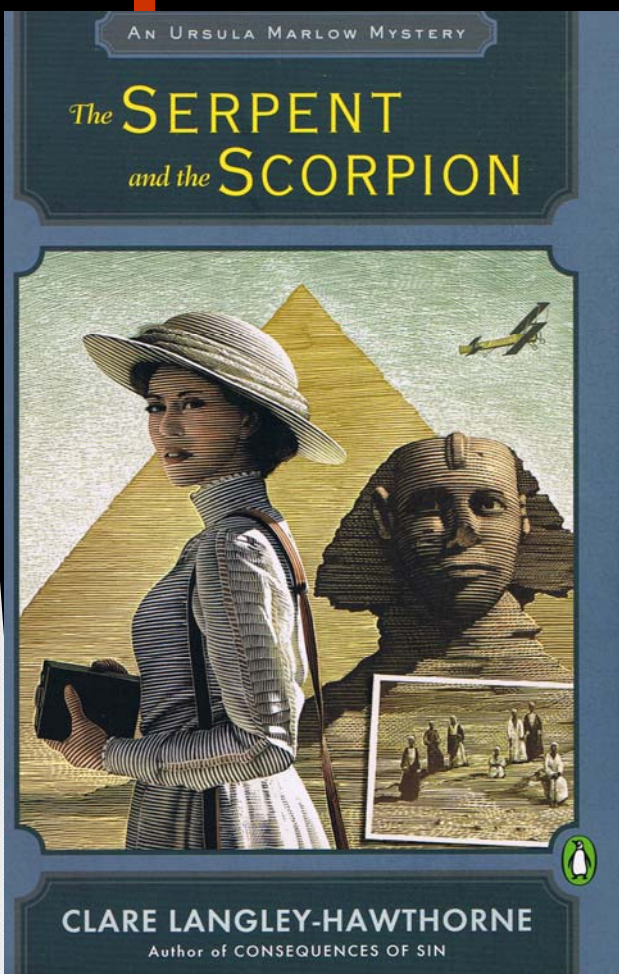


Mystery in the Valley
